We have recently acquired the three above chandeliers, all of which are available to purchase:

A late 18th century crystal chandelier in the Adam style of unusually small proportions. 6 cut S arms with Van Dyke pans and nozzles as well as 6 serpent arms with elegant swagged dressings of pear drops and round pendants. The metalwork is gilded with fine old patina. The chandelier has minor damage which is good for its age and is not currently wired but can be to customers requirements. Height 98cm Width 64cm

2 Murano Chandeliers. Both with 6 arms wired with SES lamp holders and turnover leaves between each arm. An upper tier is formed with Venetian flowers and leaves. The blue and opal version features rings and bells hanging from each arm while the gold and opal has a more intricately detailed central shaft.

Blue - Height 74cm Width 59cm & Gold - Height 64cm Width 51cm
